WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners created the Motorsports Task Force to examine the complex issues involved with establishing a motorsports facility or facilities in Lancaster County; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force carefully examined the potential economic, fiscal, social and environmental benefits and costs which could result from the development of motorsports in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force concluded motorsports presents a unique economic development opportunity for Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln, and strongly recommended immediate action be taken to encourage the development of motorsports.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners hereby declares its support for the development of motorsports in accordance with the recommendations set forth by the Motorsports Task Force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Lancaster County Board will offer appropriate government resources to assist the private sector in locating and developing a motorsports facility at a site which will maximize the economic benefits and minimize the adverse impacts on surrounding landowners and uses.
