AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN LANCASTER COUNTY) RESOLUTION NO. R-12-0056

WHEREAS, NEB.REV.STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2004) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Roca has reduced speed limits on Main Street and S. 46th Street by adopting revised village ordinances, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to install the following signs at the following locations, in accordance with Village of Roca ordinances:

- 1. Install a "Reduced Speed 35 M.P.H. Ahead" sign (W3-5) on S. 46th Street approximately 500 feet north of Roca north village limit for southbound traffic.
2. Install a Speed Limit 50 M.P.H. sign (R2-1) on S. 46th Street just north of the Roca north village limit for northbound traffic.
3. Install a Speed Limit 40 M.P.H. sign (R2-1) on Roca Road 500 feet east of S. 46th Street for westbound traffic.
4. Install a "Reduce Speed 40 M.P.H. Ahead" sign (W3-5) on Roca Road 1000 feet east of S. 46th Street for westbound traffic.
5. Relocate the existing 55 M.P.H. sign (R2-1) on Roca Road just east of S. 46th Street 500 feet east for eastbound traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to install and relocate such traffic signs at the locations designated herein.







ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCA, NEBRASKA, SETTING SPEED LIMITS ON MAIN STREET AND SOUTH 46TH STREET; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCA, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following speed limits be and are hereby established:

On Main Street: 25 m.p.h.

On South 46th Street from Main St to City Limit: 35 m.p.h.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCA, NEBRASKA, PROHIBITING THE USE OF ENGINE BRAKES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCA, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person within the municipal limits to make or cause to be made loud or disturbing noises with any mechanical device operated by compressed air and used for purposes of assisted braking on any motor vehicle; provided, however, it shall be permitted to use engine brakes in an emergency situation.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


