WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 39-2115 and § 39-2119 require the County Engineer to prepare and file a One and Six Year Road and Bridge Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, a One and Six Year Road and Bridge Improvement Program for Lancaster County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year beginning 2014, has been prepared according to law by Don R. Thomas, the Lancaster County Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning staff found the Program to be generally in conformance with the 2040 Lincoln-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, said Program has been presented at a public hearing before the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning Commission on October 16, 2013; and

WHEREAS, after the public hearing, the Planning Commission agreed with the staff recommendation and recommended approval of the Program by a vote of 8-0, finding it was in general conformance with the 2040 Lincoln-Lancaster County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2013, the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners conducted a public hearing regarding said Program; and

WHEREAS, based on public comment, the County Engineer has provided a list of public comments that may need to be investigated, as outlined in a November 25, 2013 letter to the County Board, which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the One and Six Year Road and Bridge Construction Program as prepared

and recommended by the Lancaster County Engineer is on file with the County Clerk's Office, and is incorporated herein by this reference.

WHEREAS, the County Board has found that the One and Six Year Road and Bridge Construction Program, including the additional information in the attached November 25, 2013 letter, as prepared by the County Engineer, should be adopted.





SUBJECT: Adoption of the 2014 One & Six-year Road & Bridge Program

The annual road and bridge hearing was held on November 19, 2013, and testimony was received and I would summarize those comments as follows:

Paving - SW 12th Street between Yankee Hill Road and State Highway #33 for two miles.

Paving - South 1st Street between Pioneers Blvd. And Old Cheney Road for the church.

Paving - N. 27th Street between Arbor Road and the Waverly Road.

Paving - SW 56th Street between Denton Road and Rokeby Road. This request has more to do with maintenance as the counts are not high enough for paving.

Paving - Havelock Avenue between the Stevens Creek bridge and N. 112th Street. I spoken to Pam about getting some counts during events at the Event Center.

I also received a letter from Malcolm Schools in regards to extending the Bluff Road paving on East to 105th Street. I have requested that Pam Dingman address Malcolm's request and to get new traffic counts.

There is no changes that need to be made to the program at this time and some investigating needs to be done on some of the requests.
