Roadways of approximately 2,952 linear feet in length and to include the following:

- 1) Approximately 1,901 feet of Oakview Boulevard
- 2) Approximately 423 feet of Oakview Circle
- 3) Approximately 628 feet of NW 37<sup>th</sup> Street

All located in the NW¼ of Section 5, Township 11 North, Range 6 East of the 6th Principal Meridian, Lancaster County, Nebraska, as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.



