AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION)
OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN) RESOLUTION NO. R-15-0035
LANCASTER COUNTY)

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2010) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to install the following traffic signs in Lancaster County at the following more particularly described location, which are at or near the intersection of NW 70th Street and W Mill Road:


1. Install a "Stop" sign (R1-1) on NW 70th St for northbound traffic and Install a "Stop" sign (R1-1) on W Mill Rd for westbound traffic. This will provide a 4-way stop at the intersection.
2. Install "All Way" signs (R1-4) below each Stop sign at the intersection.
3. Install a "Stop Ahead" sign (W3-1) for northbound traffic on NW 70th St approximately 500' south of the W Mill Rd intersection.
4. After two months from installation make the following sign changes at the intersection of NW 70th St & W Mill Rd
 - A. Remove the northbound and southbound "Stop" Signs on NW 70th St
 - B. Remove "all way" signs (R1-4) below each stop sign at the intersection.
 - C. Remove the northbound "Stop Ahead" Sign on NW 70th St
 - D. Install "Cross Traffic Does not stop" signs (W40-2) below the stop signs on W Mill Rd for eastbound and westbound traffic. Remove these warning signs after a six-month adjustment period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to install traffic signs at the locations designated herein.
