AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION)
OF TRAFFIC SIGNS IN) RESOLUTION NO. R-15-0050

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-6,121 (Reissue 2010) provides that placement of traffic control devices is within the jurisdiction of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineering Department has informed the County Board that it is in the best interest of the traveling public to install a "Stop" traffic sign in Lancaster County, at the following more particularly described location:

1. Install a "Stop" sign (R1-1) on N 148th Street at the intersection with Ashland Road for northbound traffic.

WHEREAS, NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-680 (Reissue 2010), provides that any local authority with respect to highways under its jurisdiction may adopt traffic regulations which are not contrary to state law and which are within the reasonable exercise of police power; and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Engineering Department has informed the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners that fishing from County Bridge H-207 located on North 162nd Street approximately 1000 feet south of Raymond Road, Lancaster County, Nebraska should be regulated; and

WHEREAS, said County Bridge is within the County Board's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. § 60-6,121 the County Board finds it is in the best interest of public safety to direct the County Engineering Department to install two "No Fishing from Bridge" (R18-1) signs on County Bridge H-207 located on North 162nd Street approximately 1000 feet south of Raymond Road in Lancaster County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of

Lancaster County, Nebraska, that authorization is hereby given to install the traffic signs at the locations designated herein.
