

# HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION FOR RURAL SOUTHERN LANCASTER COUNTY STORM VICTIMS

As a service to those residents affected by the May 22, 2004 storm that damaged properties in southern Lancaster County, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department (LLCHD) will be collecting Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) for disposal. Affected residents may arrange for pickup of their HHW by contacting LLCHD at 441-8021 before June 15, 2004.

## The following material will be accepted for disposal:

- ♦ Aerosol cans
- ♦ Automotive fluids (Brake fluid, Engine degreasers, HEET)
- ♦ Bowl cleaners, Tile cleaners, Metal cleaners, Oven cleaners
- ♦ Cleaning Products (Windex, ammonia, bleach)
- ♦ Charcoal Lighter and Charcoal
- ♦ Drain cleaners (Drano, Liquid Plumber)
- ♦ Dry cleaning solvents, Fabric cleaners, Dyes
- ♦ Gasoline, Kerosene, Diesel fuel, Lamp oil
- ♦ Glues, Adhesives, Roofing tar, Caulk
- ♦ Lawn and garden products (Fertilizers, Weed killers, Pesticides)
- ♦ Light ballasts and Capacitors from small appliances
- ♦ Mercury and Mercury containing items (thermometers, switches, chemicals)
- ♦ Parts cleaning solvents
- ♦ Paint and Painting solvents (Turpentine, Mineral spirits, Acetone)
- ♦ Pool chemicals
- ♦ Waxes and Rubbing compounds
- ♦ Wood stains, Paint strippers, Varnish

## As a courtesy to those affected residents, LLCHD will also accept other recyclable materials that are generally not accepted at HHW collections, such as:

- ♦ Lead-acid and Rechargeable batteries
- ♦ Antifreeze
- ♦ Motor oil (new and used)
- ♦ Mercury thermostats
- ♦ Propane cylinders
