

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given, that on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, at the usual polling places in the precincts of Lancaster County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will be open at 8:00 o'clock a.m. and close at 8:00 o'clock p.m.

Said election will be for the election of candidates to various offices and special issues for the cities of Hickman, Waverly and Lincoln. At such election the voters may accept or reject two (2) Proposed Constitutional Amendments whose ballot title and text will be published by the Secretary of State once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.

Unless otherwise noted, the voter can vote for one (1) candidate per race and the term of office for each race is 4 years.

GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS**

“Shall the City of Lincoln, Nebraska issue its general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$8,200,000 for the purpose of paying costs incident to engineering, acquiring, construction and/or furnishing improvements to and extensions of the city’s stormwater drainage and flood management system and measures to achieve state and federal water quality standards; such bonds to be dated at the time of their issuance and to become due and payable on such dates, bear interest at such rates, and have such other terms as may be fixed by the city at the time of their issuance”; and “Shall the city cause to be levied and collected annually a tax in addition to all other taxes upon the taxable property in the city sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same become due and payable?” VOTE FOR or AGAINST
