I, the voter to the right, declare that the enclosed ballot or ballots contained no voting marks of any kind when I received them, and I caused the ballot or ballots to be marked, enclosed in the identification envelope, and sealed in such envelope.

To the best of my knowledge and belief, I declare under penalty of election falsification that:

- (a) I am a registered voter in Lancaster County;
- (b) I reside in the State of Nebraska at the address printed to the right;
- (c) I have voted the enclosed ballot and am returning it in compliance with Nebraska law; and
- (d) I have not voted and will not vote in this election except by this ballot.

STEP 2

Mark your ballot and place your ballot in the identification envelope. Be sure to sign and complete the oath on the identification envelope. Failure to complete and sign the envelope will result in your ballot NOT being counted.

STEP 3

Place a stamp on the identification envelope and mail the ballot to the Election Office.

OR

Drop off the identification envelope with the ballot sealed inside at the Election Commissioner's office, 601 North 46th Street, Lincoln, NE 68503. For the convenience of voters, a ballot drop box is located on the north side of the Election Office and is available 24 hours a day. The ballot must be received in the Election Office no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 11th.
