

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given, that on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, at the usual polling places in the precincts of Lancaster County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will be open at 8:00 o'clock a.m. and close at 8:00 o'clock p.m.

Said election will be for the election of candidates to various offices and special bond issues for the Palmyra and Waverly School Districts. At such election the voters may accept or reject one (1) Proposed Initiative Measure whose ballot title and text will be published by the Secretary of State once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.

Unless otherwise noted, the voter can vote for one (1) candidate per race and the term of office for each race is 4 years.
