

**NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOND ELECTION**

**LANCASTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 0001  
(LINCOLN PUBLIC SCHOOLS)  
IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA**

**Tuesday, February 11, 2014**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to the qualified electors of Lancaster County School District 0001 (Lincoln Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska (the **“District”**) that a special election has been called and will be held in the District on Tuesday, February 11, 2014, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District the following proposition:

"Shall Lancaster County School District 0001 (Lincoln Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its general obligation bonds in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty-three Million Two Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$153,295,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of the following: (1) constructing, furnishing and equipping technology and security improvements to facilities of the District, (2) constructing, furnishing and equipping a new elementary school and a new middle school in the southeast area of the District, (3) constructing, furnishing and equipping a career academy high school facility, (4) constructing additions to and furnishing, equipping, renovating, remodeling and repairing facilities of the District, and (5) acquiring sites for school facilities of the District; such bonds to be issued from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Education, to bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Board of Education; and

"Shall the School District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the School District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

- FOR such Bonds and tax
- AGAINST such Bonds and tax

Electors voting in favor of such proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words **“FOR such Bonds and tax”** following such proposition, and electors voting against such proposition shall blacken the oval opposite the words **“AGAINST such Bonds and tax”** following such proposition.

### **By Mail Election**

This election will be an election by mail. All registered voters residing within Lancaster County School District 0001 (Lincoln Public Schools) will receive their ballot by mail and therefore no polling places will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County between January 22, 2014 and January 31, 2014.

### **Voter Registration Deadlines**

The deadline to register to vote at an agency, with a deputy registrar, by mail or delivered by an agent is January 24, 2014. The deadline for in-person registration is January 31, 2014, by 6:00 p.m. at the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office located at 601 N. 46<sup>th</sup> St, Lincoln, NE 68503. Any voter who changes information on a current registration or registers to vote after the ballots have been mailed but before the in-person registration deadline of January 31, 2014 by 6:00 p.m., will be given a ballot at the time of registration or change.

### **Early Voting Ballot**

If voters want an Early Voting ballot mailed to a different address than the one on record with the Lancaster County Election Commissioner, voters may complete an "Application for Early Voting Ballot" available from the office of the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County. The last day to request an Early Voting ballot to be mailed: Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at 4:00 p.m. Early Voting requests made after ballots have been mailed require an affidavit to be completed with their request. Contact the Lancaster County Election Office with questions.

### **Ballot Return Deadline**

Voted ballots that are sealed in the "Return Identification Envelope" may be returned by one of the following means:

1. U.S. Mail: place one first class postage stamp on the envelope; or
2. Hand Delivery: Ballots may be (a) delivered during regular business hours to the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, NE 68503 during regular office hours; and (b) deposited at any time 24 hours a day in the ballot drop box located in front of the building located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, NE.

NOTE: All ballots must be in the possession of the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, February 11, 2014.
