SPECIAL MAIL-IN BOND PUBLIC ELECTION CALENDAR **Lincoln Public Schools -- Tuesday, February 11, 2014**

- December 11, 2013 Received official notification from Lincoln Public Schools
- Certification and Ballot Language received from Lincoln Public Schools at least 50 days prior to election (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-559)
- December 25 Legal Holiday – Election Office Closed.
- January 1, 2014 Legal Holiday – Election Office Closed.
- January 20 Legal Holiday – Election Office Closed.
- January 22 Mail official ballots to all registered voters of **Lincoln Public Schools**.
- Ballots will be mailed in accordance to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-953 - Not sooner than the 20th day before the election and not later than the 10th day before election.
- January 22 The Automark will be available in the Election Office for voters with disabilities.
- January 23, 2014 to February 11, 2014 Ballots returned to Lancaster County Election Commissioner by mail or in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 11, 2014.
- If ballots are returned personally to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office it may be done during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.). The ballots may also be dropped off at the Election Commissioner's Official Drop Box on the north side of the Election Commissioner's Building. The drop box is available twenty-four hours a day. On Tuesday, February 11, 2014, ballots may be personally returned from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-954)
- January 24 Deadline for voters to complete voter registration applications from agencies including DMV.
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-308 and 32-310
- January 24 Deadline for postmark of mail-in voter registrations.
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-321-Postmarked on or before third Friday before election
- January 24 6:00 p.m. -- Deadline for voter registrations by Deputy Registrar.
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-306-3rd Friday preceding election.
- January 31 6:00 p.m. -- Last day for in-person voter registration – Lancaster County Election Commissioner Office open until 6:00 p.m.
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-302-2nd Friday before election
- February 5 Deadline to mail out Early Voting Ballots to voters requesting that their ballots are to be mailed to an address different than their address of record.
- 4:00 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding election (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-941)
- February 5 Last day a replacement ballot can be mailed to voter. (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-956)
- February 11 **Lincoln Public Schools Special Bond Election.**
- February 11 5:00 p.m. -- Deadline for **all** ballots (including early vote ballots) to be returned to Lancaster County Election Commission Office, 601 N. 46th St., Lincoln, NE 68503. (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-954)
