The Election Office, which is located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, will be open during the following times:

Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> -- 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.  
Wednesday, May 4<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.  
Thursday, May 5<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.  
Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup> – 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.  
Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup> – 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.  
Monday, May 9<sup>th</sup> – 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Shively also reminded voters who had requested an early/absentee ballot that the ballot must be returned to the election office no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. Early/absentee ballots may not be returned to the voter's polling location.
