## ***VILLAGE OF FIRTH SPECIAL BOND ELECTION TO BE CONDUCTED THROUGH THE MAIL***

Lincoln – The Lancaster County Election Commissioner will conduct a Special Mail-in Bond Election for the Village of Firth on Tuesday, January 11, 2011. The special election will be conducted entirely by mail.

Ballots for the special mail-in election will be mailed to all voters of the Village of Firth on Wednesday, December 22, 2010. Ballots may either be returned through the mail or by hand delivering the ballots to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln. All ballots must be returned to the Election Commissioner's Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, January 11, 2011.

Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively decided to conduct the election through the mail with the approval of Nebraska Secretary of State John Gale.

Citizens residing in the Village of Firth who are not currently registered to vote have until Monday, December 27, 2010 to register to vote through the mail or until 6:00 p.m. on Monday, January 3, 2011 to register to vote in person at the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street in Lincoln.
