## ***Election Commissioner Reminds Firth Voters to Return Ballots by Tuesday, January 11<sup>th</sup>***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively is reminding voters in the Village of Firth who have not yet returned their ballots for the January 11<sup>th</sup> all-mail special election that the ballots must be received in his office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, January 11, 2011.

The election office is open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. through Monday, January 10<sup>th</sup> and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 11<sup>th</sup>.
