## ***Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, April 26th for City General Election***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the City of Lincoln General Election is Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>.

Shively indicated that any City of Lincoln resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street. The Election Commissioner's office is open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>.

In addition, the Election Commissioner will be conducting voter registration on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at the following times and locations:

Lincoln

**Super Saver**– 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.  
27th Street and Cornhusker Highway  
Lincoln

City of Lincoln residents who will be 18 on or before November 5, 2013, have moved, changed their name, or want to change their political party affiliation must do so by Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> in order for the registration to be effective for the May 7<sup>th</sup> Lincoln City General Election.
