## ***Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> for Lincoln General Election***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the May 3<sup>rd</sup> Lincoln City General Election is Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to have a mail-in voter registration form postmarked was Friday, April 15<sup>th</sup>.
