Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, April 24th for City General Election

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the City of Lincoln Primary Election is Friday April 24th. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, April 17th.

Shively indicated that any City of Lincoln resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street. The Election Commissioner's office is currently open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, April 24th.
