Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, October 22nd for General Election

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the November 2nd General Election is Friday, October 22nd. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, October 15th.

Shively indicated that any Lancaster County resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street. The Election Commission will be open Tuesday, October 19th through Thursday, October 21st from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 22nd.

Lancaster County citizens who will be 18 on or before November 2, 2010, have moved, changed their name, or want to change their political party affiliation must do so by Friday, October 22nd in order for the registration to be effective for the November 2nd General Election.
