Voter Registration Sites for March 18th – March 21st

LINCOLN -- The Lancaster County Election Commissioner will conduct voter registration at several sites from Monday, March 18th through Thursday, March 21st. Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 5, 2013, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. The web site address is: lancaster.ne.gov/election. Mail-in voter registration applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, March 22nd in order to be effective for the April 9th Primary Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street, through Friday, March 29th.
