## **Election Commissioner Announces Voter Registration Sites**

LINCOLN -- The Lancaster County Election Commissioner will conduct voter registration at four sites between March 15<sup>th</sup> and March 19<sup>th</sup>. Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 3, 2015, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, March 20, 2015, in order to be effective for the April 7<sup>th</sup> Lincoln City Primary Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, through Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>. The office will be open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. through Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup> and will be open from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>.
