Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 4, 2014, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, October 17, 2014, in order to be effective for the November 4th General Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street, through Friday, October 24th. The office will be open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. through Thursday, October 23rd and will be open from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 24th.
