## **Election Commissioner Announces Voter Registration Sites for October 19<sup>th</sup> Through October 21<sup>st</sup>**

LINCOLN -- The Lancaster County Election Commissioner will conduct voter registration at four sites Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> through Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup>. Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 8, 2016, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

In addition, voter registration is available online if a voter has a Nebraska Driver's License or State Identification card. Online voter registration must be completed no later than Friday, October 21, 2016 in order to be effective for the November 8<sup>th</sup> General Election. Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, October 21, 2016, in order to be effective for the November 8<sup>th</sup> General Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, through Friday, October 28, 2016.
