## ***Election Commissioner Reminds Lincoln Public Schools Voters of Deadline to Return Special Election Ballots***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively reminded Lincoln Public Schools voters who have not returned their mail-in ballots for the February 11<sup>th</sup> Special Election that the ballots must be received in the Election Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>.

Shively suggests that voters mail their ballots no later than Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup> to ensure that they are received by the deadline. Ballots received after 5:00 p.m. on February 11<sup>th</sup> will not be counted.

Voters may drop their ballots off in person at the Election Office, which is located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln. The office will be open during the following times through Election Day, Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>:

Friday, February 7<sup>th</sup> - 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.  
Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup> – 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.  
Monday, February 10<sup>th</sup> – 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.  
Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> - 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

In addition, the Election Office has a ballot drop box located on the north side of the building which is available twenty-four hours a day.
