Voter Registration Deadline is Monday, May 3rd for Primary Election

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the May 11th Primary Election is Monday, May 3rd. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, April 23rd.

Shively indicated that any Lancaster County resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street. The Election Commission is open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 3rd.
