## ***Mail-in Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> for Primary Election***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively is reminding voters that the deadline for mail-in voter registration is Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> in order for the registration to be effective for the May 11<sup>th</sup> Primary Election. Anyone registering to vote for the first time or voters who have moved, changed their name, or want to change their political party affiliation must have the mail-in registration form postmarked no later than Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>. In addition, Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> is also the deadline to register to vote when applying for a driver's license or at any government agency.

Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. Forms are also located on the last page of the blue pages in the Windstream telephone book. In addition, voters may download a voter registration form from the election commissioner's web site and mail it to the election office. Residents may also register to vote **in person** at the Election Commissioner's office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street through Monday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Individuals who have questions regarding voter registration should contact the Election Office at 441-7311.
