Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. The web site address is: lancaster.ne.gov/election. Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, October 19th in order to be effective for the November 6th General Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street, through Friday, October 26th.
