## **Election Commissioner Announces Voter Registration Sites for March 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>**

LINCOLN -- The Lancaster County Election Commissioner will conduct voter registration at two sites on Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>. Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 8, 2011, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

**Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup>** – 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.  
Russ's Market  
West A Street and Coddington Avenue  
Lincoln

**Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>** – 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.  
Russ's Market  
17<sup>th</sup> Street and Washington Avenue  
Lincoln

Individuals may also register to vote through the mail. Mail-in registration forms are available at most post offices, banks, and libraries. A voter registration form is also available on the Election Commissioner's web site which may be downloaded, printed and mailed to the Election Commissioner's office. The web site address is: [lancaster.ne.gov/election](http://lancaster.ne.gov/election). Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup> in order to be effective for the April 5<sup>th</sup> Lincoln City Primary Election.

Citizens may also register to vote at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, through Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup>. The office will be open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. through Thursday, March 24<sup>th</sup> and will be open from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup>. Individuals who have questions regarding voter registration should contact the Election Commissioner's Office at 441-7311.
