Any Nebraska resident who will be 18 on or before November 2, 2010, has moved, changed his or her name, or would like to change their political party affiliation, may register to vote at the following times and locations:

Mail-in voter registration applications must be post marked no later than Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup> in order to be effective for the November 2<sup>nd</sup> General Election.
