FILING DEADLINES FOR LOCAL OFFICES NEARS

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively reminded voters that the incumbent filing deadline for offices not on the May primary ballot is 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 15th. The deadline for non-incumbents is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 2nd. A person is considered an incumbent if he/she is a present officeholder of any elected office and would like to file for the same office or a different office.

Candidates for the following offices must meet these deadlines:

Educational Service Unit 2, District 5 (4 year term)
Educational Service Unit 6, Districts 1, 5 and 7 (4 year terms)

Boards of Trustees for the Villages of Bennet, Davey, Denton, Firth, Hallam, Malcolm, Panama, Raymond, Roca, and Sprague

Candidates for Educational Service Units will file with the Nebraska Secretary of State. Candidates for Village Boards of Trustees may file with either the Lancaster County Election Commissioner or with their respective Village Clerks.
