- Dec 20, 2011 Received official notification from Lancaster County School District 0160 (Norris School District 160).
- Certification and Ballot Language received from School District (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-559 – at least 50 days prior to election)
- Feb. 22 Mail official ballots to all registered voters of **Lancaster County School District 0160 (Norris School District 160)**
- ◆ Early vote ballots will be sent only to voters requesting that their ballots be mailed to an address different than their address of record and may be sent out prior to this date.
- Feb. 23 -
- Mar. 13 Ballots returned to Lancaster County Election Commissioner by mail or in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 13th
- If ballots are returned personally to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office it must be done during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.). On Tuesday, March 13th, ballots may be personally returned from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-954)
- Feb. 24 Deadline for voters to complete voter registration applications at agencies including DMV
- Neb. Rev. Stat. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-308 and 32-310
- Feb 24 Deadline for postmark of mail-in voter registrations
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-321-Postmarked on or before third Friday before election
- Mar. 2 Last day for in-person voter registration – Lancaster County Election Commissioner/Gage and Otoe County Clerks Offices to be open until 6:00 p.m.
- Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-302-2nd Friday before election
- Mar 7 Last day a replacement ballot can be sent to voter. (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 32-956)
