Instructions To Voter

Enclosed you will find your ballot for the Norris School District in which you reside. Per Nebraska State Law this election is being conducted through the mail and no polling locations will be used. Below you will find the instructions on how to cast your ballot and return it.

Nebraska Law requires that the signature of an election official must appear at the bottom of your ballot. If there is not a signature on your ballot, please contact the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office immediately at (402) 441-7311

How to Vote the Ballot

- Use a pencil or a black or blue ink pen to mark your ballot.
- To vote you must blacken the oval completely.
- If you make a mistake in marking your ballot, do not cross out or erase the error. Write "VOID" across the face of the ballot and call the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office for instructions.

How to Return the Voted Ballot

- 1) Place the voted ballot in the Identification Envelope and seal. Do Not Place more than one ballot in the envelope.
- 2) Sign the Identification Envelope where indicated and provide your street address on the 'Residence Address' line.
- 3) If you are returning your ballot by mail, place postage of \$.45 on the envelope.
- 4) Mail or personally return your ballot to the Lancaster County Election Commissioner's Office so that it is in the possession of the Lancaster County Election Commissioner no later than 5:00 p.m., March 13, 2012.

Failure to complete and sign the Identification Envelope may result in your ballot NOT being counted.

(NORRIS SCHOOL DISTRICT 160)

"Shall Lancaster County School District 0160 (Norris School District 160) in the State of Nebraska (the "District") issue general obligation bonds of the District in a principal amount not to exceed Fourteen Million Dollars (\$14,000,000), for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing a new elementary building for grades three through five and additions to and renovations of existing school buildings, and providing the necessary furniture, equipment, and apparatus for such school building and school building additions; such bonds to be issued from time to time as may be determined by the Board of Education, to bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Board of Education; provided, however, any or all such bonds shall be redeemable at the option of the District as provided by law at the time of issuance; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes upon the taxable value of all the taxable property in the District to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"
