

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION  
VILLAGE OF PANAMA, NEBRASKA  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2014**

Public notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the Village of Panama, Nebraska (the “Village”) that a special election has been called and will be held in said Village on Tuesday, January 14, 2014, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Village the following proposition:

“Shall the Village of Panama, Nebraska (the “Village”) acquire a building at a cost not to exceed \$150,000 to be used as a community center?”

<input type="radio"/>	AGAINST	acquisition of such building

Electors voting in favor of said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words “FOR acquisition of such building” following said proposition, and electors voting against said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words “AGAINST acquisition of such building” following said proposition.

**Election by Mail**

This election will be an election by mail. Each registered voter residing within the Village will receive a ballot by mail at his/her address as it appears on the voter registration register; therefore no polling places will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County between December 24, 2013 and January 3, 2014.

**Voter Registration Deadlines**

1. December 27, 2013: is the last day for mail-in registrations, registrar registrations, delivered registrations and agency registrations (**3rd Friday prior to the election**).
2. January 3, 2014: is the last day for in-person voter registration in the office of the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County (**6:00 p.m.**).

**Early Voting Ballot**

If voters want an Early Voting ballot mailed to a different address than the one on record with the Lancaster County Election Commissioner, voters may complete an “Application for Early Voting Ballot” available from the office of the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County. **The last day to request an Early Voting ballot to be mailed: Wednesday, January 8, 2014 at 4:00 p.m.** Early Voting requests made after ballots have been mailed require an affidavit to be completed with their request. **Contact the Lancaster County Election Office with questions.**

## **Ballot Return Deadline**

Voted ballots that are sealed in the “Return Identification Envelope” may be returned by one of the following means:

1. U.S. Mail: place \$0.46 postage on the envelope to mail the ballot back; or
2. Hand Delivery: Ballots may be (a) delivered during regular business hours to the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, NE 68503 during regular office hours; and (b) deposited at any time 24 hours a day in the ballot drop box located in front of the building located at 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, NE.

**NOTE: All ballots must be in the possession of the Election Commissioner of Lancaster County no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, January 14, 2014.**
