General Information

POLL WORKER CRITERIA

Qualifications:

- Must be a registered voter in Lancaster County
- Must be able to read and write English
- Must attend poll worker training
- May not be a candidate appearing on a ballot
- Must have good eyesight and hearing

Hours:

Poll workers are required to be at their polling site from 7 a.m. to approximately 8:30 p.m. on Election Day

Compensation:


Varies, starting at minimum wage

How to Become a Poll Worker:

Poll Worker duties include:

- Setting up the polling site prior to opening of polls
- Checking in voters and issuing the proper ballots
- Closing the polling site after the polls close
