**County Treasurer Reduces Five Positions
County City Building
555 South 10th St. Room 102**

County Treasurer Andy Stebbing, announced today that he has reduced his staff from 45 FTE's, (Full time employees), to 40.

“We cut 2.5 unfilled-unfunded positions and an additional 2.5 Driver's License Clerks as a recent change in state law shifts the driver's license duties to the State of Nebraska.”

We believe the wait time for citizens will continue to be decreased at the DMV offices as changes are taking place and additional ones are forthcoming. With that in mind we are trying to hold the line on our budget and hopeful to reduce it.

Stebbing announced the following changes have been made within the last year:

- License plates and titles can be obtained at 500 West O Street.
- License plates can be obtained at 555 South 10th St. (Renewals only).
- Credit and Debit cards may be used as a source of payment. (Except Visa).
- A change in the renewal notice allowing the use of a bar code and scanner; also increasing registration mail by 100%.
- The reduction in sick time by nearly 40%.
- Expanded the drive through hours at the R St location to 7 am to 5 pm.
- Online renewal registrations have increased by 80%.

Stebbing added that the DMV wait times seldom exist Monday through Thursday.
