Lower E-processing fees for online property tax payments

Lancaster County Treasurer Andy Stebbing would like to remind taxpayers there are many options available to pay their property taxes, including mail, in person, and on the County Treasurer website are all welcome. Also, second half 2012 taxes are delinquent on August 1, 2013.

"I am pleased to announce that recently our office was able to reduce transaction fees from \$3 to \$1.50 for each electronic payment debited from a bank account to make property tax payments. Electronic payments debited from a checking or savings account allow taxpayers a secure, convenient, low cost option to paying their property taxes. Receiving money electronically allows government to operate more efficiently," said County Treasurer Stebbing.

Stebbing reminds Lancaster County taxpayers they can access their property tax bill, view information regarding payment options, and pay their property taxes online at the County Treasurer's website at:
