Recycle Unused License Plates at any Department of Motor Vehicles Office

County Treasurer, Andy Stebbing, stated the Treasurer's Office recycled 66,000 license plates in December, 2011, for a total of 4,980 pounds of scrap aluminum. They continue to accept unused plates from the public on an increasing basis. This recycling effort has resulted in approximately \$3,500 for the County's General Fund. The plates are sent to Sadoff Iron and Metal of Lincoln who shreds them safeguarding any chance of the plates returning to be fictitiously affixed to vehicle.

"We appreciate taking the old plates in at any of our three locations" said Stebbing. "Every little bit helps" he added.
