## ***Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> for General Election***

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election is Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. Voters must now register to vote in person. The date to register online or to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, October 19<sup>th</sup>.

Shively indicated that any Lancaster County resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46<sup>th</sup> Street. The Election Commissioner's office is open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup>.

In addition, the Election Commissioner will have staff available for in person voter registration on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> at the following times and locations:

Lancaster County citizens who will be 18 on or before November 6, 2018, have moved, changed their name, or want to change their political party affiliation must do so by October 26<sup>th</sup> in order for the registration to be effective for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election. Voters in neighboring counties must register to vote at their local election commissioner or county clerk's office.
