Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, March 29th for Lincoln City Primary Election

Lincoln — Lancaster County Election Commissioner David Shively today reminded voters that the last day to register to vote for the April 9th Lincoln City Primary Election is Friday, March 29th. However, voters must register to vote in person. The date to register online or to have a mail-in voter registration application form postmarked was Friday, March 22nd.

Shively indicated that any Lancaster County resident may register to vote in person at the Election Commissioner's Office, 601 North 46th Street, Lincoln. The Election Commissioner's office is open week-days from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, March 29th.

Lancaster County citizens who will be eighteen on or before November 5, 2019, have moved, changed their name, or want to change their political party affiliation must do so by Friday, March 29th in order for the registration to be effective for the April 9th Lincoln City Primary Election.
