Lancaster County Treasurer Hires Management Staff

Mendez-Lopez also served Lancaster County in the Corrections department prior to moving to the Treasurer’s office.

Wilson will serve in the role of Accountant and comes to the team with more than seventeen years of federal and state government financial management experience.
