Lancaster County Delinquent Property Taxes to be Sold in March

Lincoln, NE – February 2, 2018 – The Lancaster County Treasurer, Andy Stebbing would like to remind citizens that their 2016 delinquent taxes can be publicly advertised and offered at the tax lien sale. Taxes must be paid by March 5, 2018 to avoid a tax sale.

The annual tax sale is held the first Monday in March. “Nebraska County Treasurer’s Offices are required by state statute to publish a list of delinquent taxes and hold an annual tax sale to sell tax lien certificates on delinquent taxes”, Stebbing said. Stebbing also noted that, “To avoid delinquent taxes from going to tax sale, you can pay any time prior to March 5, 2018.” Citizens can check to see if their taxes are current or learn more about the tax sale process by visiting the County Treasurer’s website at www.Lancaster.ne.gov/treasurer or call Stebbing’s office at (402) 441-7425 with questions.
